### RECYCLING SERVICES

#### **Tire Recycling**

Scott County residents can dispose of five car tires per year at no charge. Business tires are charged at \$110 per ton. Out-of-county tires are charged at \$120 per ton. Rates are subject to change. Tires are de-rimmed and stored before shipment to Liberty Tire in Des Moines, Iowa. Liberty shreds the tires into 3 to 4 inch chips, which are used in the drainage layer of the landfill. A majority of the tires are processed into tire-derived fuel. Tires are also used to make ground cover for playgrounds and landscaping.

#### **Appliance Recycling**

All appliances are accepted at a \$5.00 per appliance fee. Refrigerators and freezers must be empty and clean. Freon from appliances is removed and reused. PCB capacitors, typically found in appliances made before the mid 1970s, are removed and incinerated. The remaining components are loaded into a roll-off container for shipment to a scrap metal recycler.

#### **Battery Recycling**

Automotive (lead-acid) batteries are accepted at the Landfill for recycling during regular hours of operation at no charge. Household (alkaline) batteries can be put in your garbage. Rechargeable batteries can be taken to area Batteries Plus locations and disposed of at no charge. Waste Commission will also accept rechargeable batteries from residents free of charge at all of our facilities during normal hours of operation. Call 563.381.1300 for more information.

#### **Oil, Oil Filter and Antifreeze Recycling**

Up to 25 gallons per month of used motor oil and antifreeze can be recycled at the Landfill at no charge. Customers with more than 25 gallons must call the Landfill at 563.381.1300 for assistance. Drained oil filters can be recycled at the Landfill during regular hours of operation. Businesses with oil filters should call 563.381.1300 for further information.

#### **Construction & Demolition Recycling and Reuse**

Construction and demolition material is accepted at the Scott Area Landfill. Asphalt shingles and select construction and demolition material are recycled.

#### **Drop-Off Recycling**

Drop-off containers for recycling commingled containers and fiber products are available at the Landfill during normal hours of operation.
