*With regard to most regulated residues, EPA's 40 CFR 261.7 says: "A container... is empty if:

1. All wastes have been removed that can be removed using the practices commonly employed to remove materials from that type of container, e.g.,
2. No more than 2.5 centimeters (one inch) of residue remain on the bottom of the container..."

For residues of "P-list" products specifically listed by name in 40 CFR 261.33(e), EPA says the container is empty only "if the container... has been triple rinsed using a solvent capable of removing" the product, or has been cleaned by another method shown to achieve equivalent removal.

According to Iowa Code - No free liquids or waste containing free liquids shall be disposed in a sanitary landfill.

1. Waste Commission of Scott County requires that the containers be triple rinsed and aerated.
2. Do not crush containers as visual inspection is required.
3. Contact 563-381-1300 for disposal instructions.
4. Failure to contact the landfill before disposal may result in refusal at the gate.
